

## Update on 15 minutes ISP derogation requests - The submission of derogation requests

Nordic TSOs' public consultations on revised NBM roadmap in 2019 and informal dialogue with NordREG

Svenska Kraftnät, Fingrid and Energinet requests for national derogations from the ISP15 deadline pursuant to EBGL\*: 18 December 2020.

TSOs' requested deadline: 22 May 2023.

EBGL not applicable in Norway.

Statnett coordination with the other Nordic TSOs aiming also at implementing ISP15 on 22 May 2023.

\* **EBGL**: Commission Regulation 2017/2195 establishing a guideline on electricity balancing



## Update on 15 minutes ISP derogation requests - The processing of the derogation requests

NordREG aim to coordinate decisions on derogation requests even if decisions are national

- DUR, EI, and EV each have requested further information to decide on the derogation requests -> Extension of deadline for the decisions
- DUR, Ei, and EV expect to decide on EN's, SvK's, and FG's requests early 2021, and not necessarily simultaneously



## Update on 15 minutes ISP derogation requests - The regulatory constraints

Requirements in EBGL, formally and in substance, when granting a derogation at the request of the TSO or at the NRA's own initiative

- Possible for the regulators to decide a deadline at their own initiative, regardless of the TSO's requested date
- >A derogation can only be granted once

➤The decision has to be well-founded and based on a robust, yet ambitious timeline
